## **Training Descriptions**

### **Waiver and Funding 101**

Gain a basic understanding of the different types of waivers that are available in Ohio, while gathering an overall perspective on funding as a whole.

### **Resilience Model**

Participants can expect to learn practical tools and approaches to help a person move along the path to trauma recovery. These are research-based and easy to use by anyone. Examples used in this session will help participants: understand trauma recovery as a healing journey; use Affirmations for Rebounding to heal from past adversity; Use Predict, Practice, and Plan B to engage in positive daily routines; and more.

### **End of the Year Wrap-Up**

Superintendent Dan Ottke will reflect on Clermont DD's journey throughout 2017 and will introduce items for future planning and upcoming events in 2018. An additional program may be added to this session.
