SUPERVISOR

Provides habilitative services to children, ages birth to three (3), with developmental delays and/or disabilities or who are at significant developmental risks due to conductive or sensorineural hearing loss and their families; services include assessment of communication function, home-based service delivery (i.e. auditory training, communication training or speech-language training, sign language support and resources for interested families) via family coaching model, providing appropriate referrals to outside sources, supporting parental empowerment, education and advocacy. Provides consultative services. Services may be provided in person or via technology. Becomes familiar with local/regional deaf community and integrates families into deaf community to the extent each family desires. Assists families in obtaining hearing screenings and tests to determine accurate hearing levels of infants and toddlers; accesses audiological services as needed; facilitates parental understanding of audiological testing results from outside sources; coordinates other assessments to determine current levels of development in all areas; accesses appropriate team members to perform further assessment as needed: informs parents of impact of hearing loss on development; presents families with possible communication methodologies in an objective, non-biased manner; assists families in identifying needs and goals as they pertain to their infant/toddler. Coordinates the writing and implementation of the IFSP outcomes; assures each family has a service coordinator and works with service coordinator to ensure all service needs addressed; if serving as the Primary Service Provider for the child, will assist with scheduling therapists in an efficient manner based on family schedules, either in home or at other settings; provide direct service to child and family as identified in the IFSP; works with families in their understanding of the IFSP and the implementation of services and goals identified on the IFSP.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Bachelor's Degree in early childhood education, special education, deaf education or a related field that involves children with hearing loss. 1 year experience working with children ages birth to three or children with a hearing loss. Possession of or ability to obtain one of the following: Ohio Department of Education Early Childhood Intervention Specialist License; Ohio Department of Education Early Childhood license; Ohio Department of DD Early Intervention Certification; Ohio Department of Education Certified Audiologist; Licensed Audiologist as required under Ohio Revised Code; Ohio Department of Education Certified Speech Language Pathologist; Licensed Speech Language Pathologist as required under Ohio Revised Code. Must be able to lift, carry, and position children in a safe manner.
